Academic Entry Requirements

- Year 9: Completed Year 7 and Year 8 (in own country). Strong grades and excellent academic reference. IELTS 4.5 level or equivalent
- Year 10: Completed Year 8 or Year 9 (in own country). Strong grades and excellent academic reference. IELTS 5.0 level or equivalent
- Year 11: This is only for students already studying for GCSE in a British International School. Strong grades and excellent academic reference
